Interested in a job at the Cambridge Clinic?

1. The Cambridge Clinic website www.cambridgeclinic.co.nz will give you an idea about the work that we do.
2. Contact the Cambridge Clinic (office@cambridgeclinic.co.nz) to arrange to come in for an informal chat. We will provide you with a position description which outlines the details of the job and on-call roster expectations.
3. Please email us your CV, cover letter and contact details of 2 referees (office@cambridgeclinic.co.nz)
4. You may be required to attend a job interview at the Cambridge Clinic.
5. Once successful we will provide you with:
 - Dates, a draft programme and an Expression of Interest form for the next MEDSAC Medical/Forensic Management of Adult Sexual Assault course www.medsac.org.nz
 - Dates for upcoming peer review meetings

Process following offer of employment at the Cambridge Clinic

1. Sit in and observe at least one case prior to attending training (Unpaid)
2. Attend Cambridge Clinic peer review meetings held 4-6 times a year
3. Attend the 3 day MEDSAC Medical/Forensic Management of Adult Sexual Assault course in Auckland, held annually. (Course fees, travel and accommodation costs will be covered)
4. Join MEDSAC as an associate member. (Membership fees will be paid by the Cambridge Clinic)
5. Sit in and observe two cases (Paid observation fee)
6. Perform two cases with supervision. (Paid training fee) (More supervision may be required at the discretion of the supervisor and/or trainee)
7. Go onto the Cambridge Clinic roster
